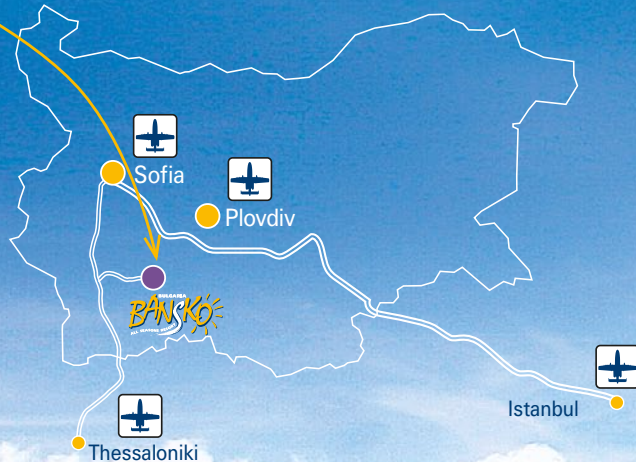

By car Bansko lies in the South-Eastern part of Bulgaria, at the tip of the Pirin National Park. Once you arrive at the airport in Sofia or Plovdiv, there are a number of ways to travel to Bansko. Bansko lies two-and-a-half hours' drive from Sofia, although the journey time can lengthen to three or four hours on busier weekends. Quickest route is to take the main E79 south to Simitli, from where a well-marked east-bound turn leads over the Predela Pass to Bansko.

By air Closest airport: Sofia Airport.

By bus There are regular bus lines to major cities in Bulgaria.
